- Due to space constraints, artwork dimensions must not exceed 900mm x 900mm.
- All 2D works must be submitted with a means to hang them that incorporates string/picture wire (due to our hanging system). All 3D works must be provided with a suitable plinth/support system.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

GENERAL

- All artworks are to be submitted for sale:
- Artworks are to be exclusively for sale through Blue Mountains Artfest (BMA) for the duration of the exhibition and cannot be sold on any other platform during that time;
- Artworks must not have been previously shown in this exhibition;
- · Artworks must be the original work of the entrant;
- Digital and Photographic works must be limited edition, numbered prints;
- All artworks must have the Artist's name, price, and title of the work clearly marked on the back;
- Limit of two (2) artworks per Artist.

ENTRY FEES, COMMISSION & PAYMENT FOR WORKS SOLD

- Entry fees are \$20 for the first piece of work entered and \$15 for the second with a limit of two (2) per entrant.
- Entry fees may be paid by by cash, cheque or EFT at the time of delivering artworks. Alternatively, cheque payable to Wentworth Falls Public School P&C may be sent with entry forms.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- A commission of 25% of the sale price will be charged on all works sold.
- Artists will be paid for works sold, less BMA commission, via EFT into their nominated bank account.
- Entries are only confirmed as received upon receipt of a confirmation email from the Blue Mountains Artfest Committee.



FRAMING & PRESENTATION

- Artworks cannot exceed 900mm x 900mm, due to hanging limitations.
- All 2D works must be supplied ready to hang. For our hanging systems artworks will be strung using D-hooks or staples.
- Any artwork requiring repair or deemed unsuitable for hanging will be rejected.
- 2D works must be mounted, framed or stretched over a frame, with suitable hanging system attached (see above).
- Artists must supply a suitable plinth to exhibit 3D works.
- All paintings must be suitably finished (i.e. dry) and ready for hanging. Wet paintings will not be accepted for hanging.

CURATING

- BMA is an open exhibition. All submitted artworks are eligible for inclusion however BMA reserves the right to select works to be exhibited.
- BMA reserves the right to not exhibit any artwork considered not to be in the spirit of the event, or incomplete.
- Due to space limitations not all entries will be displayed. Every attempt will be made to display at least one artwork per artist. The Entry Form will ask artists to nominate an order of preference for hanging. Any entry fees will not be refunded.
- Works not selected for hanging can be collected at the nominated collection time:
- BMAC reserves the right to determine the way in which selected artworks are hung.

INSURANCE & GST

- Exhibitors are advised to insure their artworks. While every possible care will be taken when handling entered artworks, no responsibility is accepted for loss, theft of damage while in custody or transit, nor for works collected outside the nominated time.
- GST is the personal responsibility of artists, should their works be sold.



CANCELLATION

- Should the event be cancelled prior to the event opening due to events outside
 of our control, including but not limited to fire, flood, or COVID-19 outbreak, all
 artists will receive a full refund of any entry fees paid.
- In the instance the event is cancelled after the official Opening Night has commenced, artists will not be eligible for entry fee refunds.

DELIVERY & COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS

- Artworks are to be delivered to the school on Wednesday 6.November 2024 between 3pm and 6pm. Earlier entries will not be received.
- All exhibiting artists are expected to present in-person for collection of unsold works and confirmation of sales between 3pm and 4:30pm on Sunday 10.November. Please note, uncollected works cannot be stored.
